-Red button is Delete -Green Button is Actions

LAST

Returns to the previously tuned channel.

A, B, C, D

These functions are pre-set by your cable provider.

CHANNEL ~/~

Selects the next higher or lower channel.

FAV

Displays favorite channels.

LIVE

Displays live television programming.

VCR/DVD/VOD KEYS

Perform standard VCR and DVD functions when in VCR and DVD mode, and Video-On-Demand functions when in CABLE mode.

NUMBER PAD

Enter numbers to tune to channels.

Also, make numeric entries on on-screen menus.

NOTE: You can also use the CH 4/T or the program
guide as alternate ways to tune to channels.

ASPECT(#)

Change the HD screen viewing aspect.

PIP CH▲/▼

Selects the next higher or lower channel in the PIP (Picture-in-Picture) window.

MOVE

Moves the PIP (Picture-in-Picture) window to another location on the screen.
